#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Joseph and Mary were just simple people who loved God. God chose them for a special mission: to be the parents to Jesus, the Savior of mankind and the light of the world. Matthew 1:18-25, The Birth of Jesus



## HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Sit down with your kids and look through the Christmas cards that you have received in the mail this year from family and friends. Talk about what these people mean in your lives. Remind your kids that Jesus came not only because he loves us, but because he loves each of the people represented in those cards. Take a few moments to pray for each person.



### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did God change his mind?
- How does Jesus' birth show us that God keeps his promises?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

### TO PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
