Giving at Grace Church

Here are a few things to think about as you give or consider giving to the Lord's work at Grace Church...

If you are interested in a year end giving record for tax purposes:

- 1. You must use a Grace Church giving envelope and your name must be written on it. Envelopes can be placed in the bins near the doors at the back of the auditorium.
- 2. If you have an envelope pack now and there are left over envelopes, feel free to use what you have. (The notation of 1st Sunday, 2nd Sunday, etc is for your benefit only and is not used by the church.)
- 3. Envelope booklets are available in the Lobby at the Information Board whenever you need them.
- 4. You are always able to access your giving record via Breeze. If you need a link to set up your Breeze account click HERE. If you are currently giving through the Grace Church envelopes, financial statements will be emailed to you at the end of January.

If you do not need giving records, but want to give to the Lord's work at Grace, tithes and offerings are collected in the bins near the doors at the back of the auditorium.
