### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

After Adam and Eve disobeyed God in the Garden, many more people chose to disobey God and hurt each other. Only Noah and his family still chose to obey God. So because Noah believed God and obeyed Him, God protected Noah and his family from the huge flood that covered the whole earth. Genesis 6:9-22, Genesis 7:5-24; Noah and the Flood



# HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Take a moment this week when you can point out all the things you personally do and have done to protect your kids - from hiding dangerous medicines to fencing the vard to providing safety equipment, etc. Ask the kids how they know that God protects them as well.
