Six Keys to Developing Biblical Convictions:

1. COMMITMENT to the teachings of Scripture. Psalm 119:105
2. CONSTRUCTION of actions and attitudes that align themselves with Scriptural teaching (habits). Mark 12:30-31
3. CONSISTENTLY living out these truths in the real world. 2 Timothy 3:16-17
4. CHECK-UP or evaluation with accountability. Proverbs 27:17
5. COURAGE to model these in our daily lifestyle and if need be, to stand alone. Daniel 3:16-18
6. CONFIDENCE in the character and competency of God. John 3:16
