THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE STORY LOOKS LIKE IT MIGHT BE OVER



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

From the very first time Adam and Eve disobeyed God, to the time you disobeyed your parents or said something mean to a friend, sin has been happening in the world. Sin happens when we disobey God. There is a price to pay for every sin, just like when you disobey mom and dad and get grounded. However, the punishment for sin is much greater. It means that we can't be with God in Heaven forever. However, when Jesus died on the cross, he took the punishment we should have gotten so that we can be in Heaven with God forever! Luke 23:32-47, Jesus Dies on the Cross



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

When you go shopping this week, draw your kids' attention to the price of the things you buy. Everything has a price in this world. Ask your kids what the price of sin is, and ask them how God paid that price.

AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Jesus die?
- How was Jesus the only person who could pay for our sins?
- How can we go to paradise with Jesus?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"I know the plans I have for you,' announces the Lord. 'I want you to enjoy success. I do not plan to harm you. I will give you hope for the years to come." Jeremiah 29:11 (NIrV)



III PARENT TIME:

What you need to know: The price of sin is death - eternal separation from God. Jesus paid the price for us when he died on the cross. Jesus never sinned, but because he died, we can have eternal life. Ask your kids if they have questions about making a decision to accept Jesus as their Savior so they can receive eternal life.
